Across our Academy Trust we continue to work on new ways to promote good attendance and punctuality at our schools. This term we have introduced a new initiative called "OTIS Money". This is a scheme where classes work together and are rewarded for good attendance with special vouchers which we have called "OTIS Money". Classes will receive the following amounts:

Please bring in your creations. Maximum size is on A4 paper or card with your name, year group and date of birth on the back.

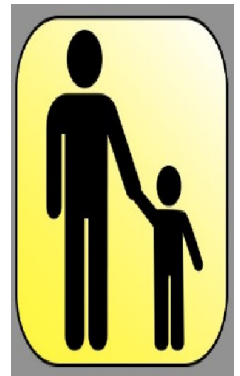

Research has shown that reading for just 5 to 10 minutes in an evening can have a huge impact on both reading ability and enjoyment. Please can you encourage your child to bring their book bag and use their special reading bookmarks.

In order to ensure the safety of children in Reception and Key Stage 1 (Y1 & Y2), we ask that parents collect children from their classroom door each day. This also allows for important information to be passed on. If a different adult to usual is sent to collect your child, please can you contact school and provide a password to be used when handing your child over.



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Every evening we run our after school paid child care provision called "Club FM". This club runs from 3.15pm - 6.00pm and is run by experienced school staff. Each night children are able to join in with a range of activities, games, crafts, sports and ICT.
